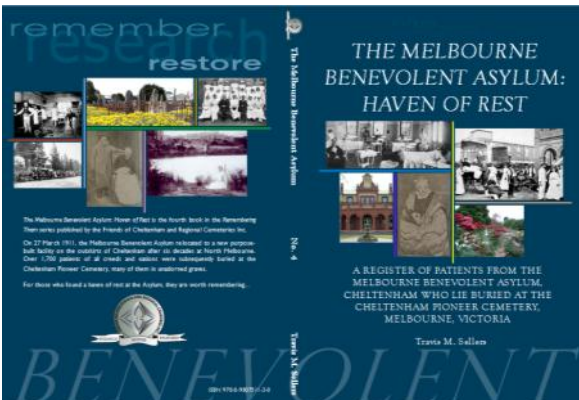
In March 1911, the Melbourne Benevolent Asylum relocated from North Melbourne to a new purpose built facility on the outskirts of Cheltenham. Over 1,700 inmates were subsequently buried at the Cheltenham Pioneer Cemetery between 1911 and 1976, the vast majority in unadorned graves.
